



NENA Traffic Island Landscape Coordinator

Job Description:

Coordinate care of landscaping on North End traffic islands and chicanes.

Duties:

- Recruit and organize regular volunteers to be responsible for litter pick up, weeding, and occasional maintenance of each of the North End's traffic islands and chicanes.
- Oversee planting and maintenance of landscape, with a focus on low-growing, drought-tolerant plants.
- Coordinate an annual volunteer spring-cleanup work party to rake up leaves, remove dead plants, and generally beautify all North End traffic islands at the beginning of the growing season — around late March.
- Cultivate relationships with local nurseries and garden experts for advice and potential donations.
- Report back to NENA Board on a regular basis.

2018 season:

Recruit volunteers, both regular volunteers to “adopt” an island and occasional volunteers to help weed, plant, prune, water, and clean up derelict islands. Re-plant in the fall as necessary.

2019 season:

Host a spring work party and oversee regular maintenance throughout the year.

Qualifications:

Preferably a North End resident with interest or experience in recruiting and coordinating volunteers. Landscaping experience valuable, but not necessary.

Payment:

\$600 stipend for approximately 40 hours of work (\$15/hour) annually

Supervision/Accountability:

Report to the NENA board in October 2018, February 2019, July 2019, and October 2019
