4. Boise School Board of Trustees Election – Candidates Matthew Shapiro & Krista Hasler

5. Hyde Park Street Fair

7. Streets Committee

8. Flags on Harrison

- Typically, Idaho state and US flags have been hung on Harrison for most/all of the "patriotic" holidays, for a week or so per holiday, depending on volunteer availability.
- b. Multiple community groups have asked to hang flags for up to a month (i.e. Pride, Black History Month, etc).
- c. Proposal to have Idaho/US flags hang from Memorial Day through Labor Day, with the third bracket dedicated to an approved community group flag, for a specified (TBD) duration.
- d. Proposal to create a flag committee to consider and advise.
